Yves Komaclo

Yves Komaclo is the Oikocredit West Africa Regional Manager. He manages a 60 Million diversified portfolio of 80+ agriculture, renewable energy and inclusive finance projects across the ECOWAS region. Prior to joining Oikocredit in 2009, Yves was division chief, internal audit at UBA Bank in Benin.

He previously worked in London as Manager Corporate Accounts at Tyco International, and before that worked at management consulting firm Booz Allen & Hamilton. He led privatization, industry analysis, merger and acquisition and operational auditing engagements in the telecoms, technology and finance areas. Yves was Director of Information Technology and Operations of the Nigeria National Lottery and Network Manager at the African Development Bank in Abidjan.

Mrs. Ngom is currently the Division Manager for energy financial solutions within the energy complex of the African Development Bank. She was Chief Investment Officer in the Bank's private sector department where she played a key role in transactions in the Energy and transport sectors.
